

Tin and base metals explorer makes strong ASX debut

PERTH, Dec 18 AAP - Tin and base metals explorer Bellevue Resources Ltd made a solid debut on the Australian stock market today, with its shares closing 35 per cent at 27 cents.

Bellevue is currently exploring its wholly owned Running River tin project north-west of Townsville in Queensland.

The Perth-headquartered company is chaired by the executive director of the largest public relations consultancy in Western Australia, Paul Niardone.

The company has offered shares to investors at 20 cents each to raise \$3.5 million under its initial public offer.
